### **Surveyor 3 – Party Chief**

Qualified candidates must demonstrate a strong knowledge of land surveying principles and practice, possess strong organizational skills, as well as verbal and written communication skills. You must be able to work independently and lead a survey crew effectively. Although most of the survey calculations are performed by office personnel, the ability to perform field calculations is required.

The successful candidate will work under the direction of a survey manager leading a 2-person survey crew and work independently as a single-man survey crew using GPS or robotic total stations. Party Chiefs will work from a company truck and are required to maintain a valid California driver's license.

Projects are primarily located throughout the San Joaquin Valley, Sacramento Area, and Northern California, and the Bay Area, but the candidate must be willing and prepared to travel throughout California on occasion. Assignments will include Control surveying, boundary surveying, topographic surveying, and construction staking.

**Essential duties and Responsibilities** of a successful candidate include, but are not limited to:

- Experience with day to day field survey operations, equipment and procedures to provide accurate data.
- Perform both field and office surveying operations.
- AutoCAD drafting.
- Perform various levels of survey calculations.
- Leadership role of survey field crew.
- Coordinate with and assist survey Project Managers.
- Perform all types of survey projects such as: Construction, ALTA, Topography, Boundary, Control, Subdivision, Monitor, Detail as-built mapping, etc.
- Use manual and robot total stations, GPS, data collection, various surveying software, AutoCAD, etc.



- Provides clear and concise field notes (including sketches).
- Oversees daily maintenance of survey equipment, supplies and vehicle.
